《英语》(Join In)是依据教育部《义务教育英语课程标准》的教育理念和教学目标要求,吸纳现代外语教育在非英语国家对少年儿童实施英语教学的研究成果,并根据我国小学英语教育的实际,由外语教学与研究出版社和英国剑桥大学出版社合作开发的一套小学三年级起点的英语教材。
